

Scientific publications related to the Hestia Chair's areas of interest produced in Spain in 2018

In accordance with the objectives of the Hestia Chair, we feel it is worthwhile to provide the scientific community a document listing the most relevant scientific publications produced in Spain in 2018, in relation to the chair's areas of interest (integrated health and social care, chronicity, multi-morbidity, dependence, social needs...).

This document classifies the studies based on a number of different variables (key words, type of study, degree of multicentricity), includes a shortcut to each article's abstract (via a link to PubMed) and features an interactive map indicating the geographical location of the centres undertaking the studies.

Our idea is to update the document annually and create an annex listing the oral presentations given at congresses or other scientific meetings related to the Chair's areas of interest.

Methodology

- 1. Review of the articles published in 2018 in the leading international journal on integrated care (*International Journal of Integrated Care*)
- 2. Selection of the keywords specified in the articles that are related to the Chair's areas of interest (integrated care; delivery of health care, integrated; social services; cross-sector service delivery; service integration; community based primary health care; innovative models of care; chronic conditions; chronic patients; chronic diseases; patient complexity; transitional care; home hospitalisation; complex care needs; multimorbidity; integrated care systems; integrated policy)
- 3. Bibliographic search on PubMed using each keyword + Spain + 2018
- 4. Selection of publications considered to be of interest because of their relation to the Chair's areas of interest
- 5. Creation of a database in Excel format with the following indicators: keyword used in search, type of study (clinical or other), multicentricity of study, article title, journal in which article was published (with a link to the abstract on PubMed), autonomous community, city and centre that appear in the list of authors
- 6. Creation of a map (Google Maps) showing the location of the centres in Spain that appear in the list of publications





Results

The selection includes a total of 34 articles

The keywords that generated selected articles are: "integrated care" (20), "multimorbidity" (5), "chronic diseases" (7), "social services" (1) and "home hospitalisation" (1)

Of the 34 articles selected, 11 are clinical studies (intervention and patient outcomes). The rest are miscellaneous: bibliographic reviews; project descriptions; issues related to management, measurement and assessment; organisational models, etc.

Most studies are multicentric (11 international, 3 state and 11 at autonomous community level)

The number of publications per autonomous community is: Catalonia (21), Aragon (4), Andalusia (3), Valencian Community (3), Madrid (3), Basque Country (3), Balearic Islands (1), Canary Islands (1), Cantabria (1) Castile–La Mancha (1) and Castile León (1).

Conclusions

The scientific evidence relating to integrated health and social care generated in Spain during the period under review (2018) is relatively low and is more closely linked to the design and theoretical assessment of organisational models than clinical intervention. Social aspects are severely under-represented. Most of the studies are multicentric, a highly positive and essential aspect when looking to provide scientific evidence for an issue such as service integration. Catalonia is the autonomous community with the highest number of publications, followed by Aragon, Andalusia, the Valencian Community, Madrid and the Basque Country.
